WebSleep disordered sleep, sleep apnea Excessive follicles, which is defined as 25 or more follicles that are 2 mm to 10 mm in a single view of a transvaginal ultrasound, may be present in PCOS. WebObstructive Sleep Apnea . Obstructive sleep apnea (OSA) is a sleep-related breathing disorder that involves a decrease or complete halt in airflow despite an ongoing effort to breathe. It occurs when the muscles relax during sleep, causing soft tissue in the back of the throat to collapse and block the upper airway.
